	<p><b>Crate or pen</b></p> <p>For a soft-sided fabric crate expect to pay around £40 for the largest size (over 1m in length) and Ebay is always a good starting point. Most of these fabric ones are easy to collapse and erect and then fold flat for storage. The metal crates tend to be slightly more expensive. Puppy pens are another option and again fabric or metal ones can be purchased from website such as Ebay and expect to pay around £65 for a metal heavy duty pen at least.</p> <p><a href="http://www.ebay.co.uk">www.ebay.co.uk</a></p>
	<p><b>Bedding</b></p> <p>Vet bed tends to be bought by the length or full rolls can also be found and again Ebay is a great source for this.</p> <p><a href="http://www.ebay.co.uk">www.ebay.co.uk</a></p>
	<p><b>Beds</b></p> <p>We are often asked about the trampoline style beds we have at the Kennel and these are made by a company called Kuranda and we buy the aluminium framed ones, but there are similar versions available such as the Hi K9 beds. 	<p><b>Water bowls</b></p> <p>There are various non-spill water bowls on the market that range from just a few pounds up to £25 (for the Herm Sprenger stainless steel water bowl). Again look at Ebay or local pet stores. We would definitely recommend something like the Road Refresher bowl for putting in the car or in your puppy's crate. 	<p><b>Bowl Stands</b></p> <p>There are 2 main types of bowl stand; metal framed adjustable stands for 1 or 2 bowls or static height plastic stands and feeders. 	<p><b>Collars</b></p> <p>A soft starter collar for a young puppy can be bought from your local pet shop or from the Xtradog website. For a growing puppy a few months later the Dogmatic head collar can be bought direct from their own website. 	<p><b>Rubber Equine/stable Mats</b></p> <p>For outdoor areas such as kennel and runs or even patio areas, the rubber horse mats are excellent for cushioning the floor and also easy to clean. They come in different thicknesses, but can be very heavy and usually come in 6' x 4' size.
